

## ULNAR NERVE TRANSPOSITION (SUB-CUTANEOUS)

- ❖ 3-5 days post-op:
  - O Remove post-op dressings
  - O Keep incision site dry for 2 weeks
  - O Begin active elbow and wrist range of motion
  - No splint required
  - O Lifting restrictions: < 10# for 1 month
  - O Edema reduction, as needed
- ❖ 2 weeks post-op:
  - O Can follow up with M.D. in Hand Therapy
  - O Continue range of motion, edema reduction with home program
- ❖ 4 weeks post-op:
  - Advance lifting to tolerance
- 6 weeks post-op:
  - O Return appointment with M.D.
  - No restrictions
